



Tomato & Vegetable Insect Killer

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

What it is: Safer Brand Tomato & Vegetable Insect Killer is a specially formulated combination of insecticidal soap and botanical pyrethrins which kills insects on contact yet is gentle on plants.

What it kills: aphids, asparagus beetles, bean beetles, cabbage loopers, caterpillars, Colorado potato beetles, cucumber beetles, diamond-backed moth, flea beetles, imported cabbageworm, leafhoppers, plant bugs, tomato hornworm and whiteflies.

Where to use it: asparagus, beans, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, cucumbers, eggplant, herbs, kale, lettuce, peppers, potatoes, squash and tomatoes.

How to use it: *Shake Well.* Use at first sighting of insects. Thoroughly moisten all plant surfaces where insects are feeding or resting. Apply every 7 to 10 days when insects are present or as needed to prevent damage. **CAN BE USED UP TO THE DAY OF HARVEST.**

NOTE: Use with caution on tender new foliage.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:

CAUTION: Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

FIRST AID:

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:
